

Driving for Mosaic during the Jewish Outdoor Escape

Due to insurance regulations, anyone driving as an “official” Mosaic driver must allow us to check their Motor Vehicle Records. Any request by Mosaic to drive anyone unrelated to that driver must have their MVR pulled.

For simplicity, our volunteer transportation coordinator will pull the record for you. You will need to sign a permission form with pertinent data. We will then pull your MVR record via <https://checkr.com>. Mosaic will contact you once we determine you will be a Mosaic Driver.

We will allow anyone to drive for Mosaic if you have a good driving record. You are allowed one or two minor traffic tickets but no significant accidents where you are found at fault or DUIs. Please do not put us in any embarrassing situations by volunteering to drive if you do not pass the MVR check.

Our Volunteer Transportation Coordinator will contact you during this process. You must respond to invitation emails from [Checkr.com](https://checkr.com) and other emails from transportation@mosaicoutdoor.org.

For Mosaic Van Drivers:

As an extra step, please send a photocopy of your current Driver’s License to transportation@mosaicoutdoor.org, as we need to supply a copy to the rental company.
